We are excited to be able to host Alaskan author, Meagan Macvie, on December 17 at 2pm, for a reading, Q/A, and signing of her recently published young adult novel. "What makes Meagan Macvie's *The Ocean in My Ears* so compelling is the way it lands us in the sweet spot between the unique and the universal. Meri's uneasy coming of age mirrors that of girls all over America, but it's also richly and beautifully hers alone. As she wrestles with sex and death, love and bigotry, faith and doubt on Alaska's rugged and isolated Kenai Peninsula, we witness her passage from messy adolescence into complex young adulthood, at once transcending the limitations of home and family and embracing them despite their many flaws. This is a gorgeous, funny, and moving novel about the bittersweet end of childhood."—Scott Nadelson, author of Between You and Me

Meagan grew up in the Kenai/Soldotna area, writing poems about injustice and hot boys. She left Alaska to study poetry and literature at the University of Idaho, then spent fifteen years in government communications before breaking up with her career to pursue creative writing. In 2014, she earned her MFA in fiction at Pacific Lutheran University's Rainier Writing Workshop. She lives and plays in the Pacific Northwest with her husband, daughter, dog, cat, two stinky goats, and many chickens.

With the Christmas holiday coming on soon, we want you to know that we'll be closed December 25 and January 1.




Just in time for the holidays, the students at Cooper Landing School have written instructions for making their favorite dishes. Try at your own risk!
