### THE STORY

Diligent or desperate or both, this race celebrates prospectors who settled Hope and Sunrise and laid a road up the glacial Palmer Creek Valley where they dug mineshafts into the rocky ridges following veins of gold and silver.

### THE DETAILS

Start at Hope School and choose between foot power for the 4 and 8 mile out-and-back Quartz and Silver Grinders or pedal power to grind up the 11 mile Palmer Creek Road in the Gold Grinder. There, you may opt to haul rocks to earn pay dirt in the form of a time deduction. Enjoy a scenic, social cycle down and join the awards party at the Creekbend Cafe.
